



## Donating Stock to the Diocese of Orlando for your Parish or School



The Diocese encourages gifts of stock via electronic transfer from your brokerage. It's the fastest and easiest way to give stock to benefit your parish or school!

Just follow these two easy steps:

1. Write or phone your broker authorizing them to transfer X number of "XYZ Security" in kind to our Fidelity Investments account:

**Federal Employer Identification # 59-1215378**

Note: Shares should be transferred in "Cash" not "Margin".

2. Please contact me, or have your broker do so, so that I can identify the stock as coming from you and acknowledge you for tax purposes. Please send the completed forms to the address reference above. **Do not sign the stock certificate.**

**Just a Reminder...** in order to take full advantage of the tax laws surrounding the gifting of appreciated securities, remember that the shares must have been held by you for at least one year. The Diocese is pleased to provide this stock transfer program as a service to our parishes and schools and does not charge a handling fee of any kind. Always consult a tax professional before making a decision to donate shares.
